OSCAR & MA'S STORY

Job Creation For Underserved Populations

Oscar & Ma was founded by Scott Green, an Orange County entrepreneur, venture capitalist, and philanthropist who was inspired to create employment opportunities for people who face significant challenges entering the job market.

In 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic was causing increased unemployment, disproportionately among marginalized populations.

Scott's vision was to create a nonprofit events organization that employs and trains individuals from underserved communities, while also providing valuable marketing and event services to other companies and nonprofits.

The organization was launched in October 2020 with the goal of starting locally and expanding nationally to provide jobs and job training to thousands of people in need of sustainable employment.





EMPLOYING UNDERSERVED POPULATIONS

Oscar & Ma's mission is to create employment opportunities for people with barriers to employment, including the formerly incarcerated, foster youth, unhoused, and survivors of domestic violence.

In the United States:

- Formerly incarcerated individuals are unemployed at a rate of 27%.¹
- Youth that age out of the foster system have an unemployment rate of 47% 69%, depending on age and gender.²
- Unemployment among people who are unhoused ranges from 57% to more than 90%.³

THE ACADEMY PROGRAM

Oscar & Ma offers an on-the-job training academy where employees can apprentice to learn a particular job over the course of a year.

Programs for employees include personal and professional development, exposure to a professional work environment, and job placement services.

- Each trainee has a 1-year commitment.
- Trainees work 20 hours a week.
- The company trains 16 people per year (4 per quarter).

In addition, support services are provided including logistical help (transportation support), professional wardrobe, and career assessment training.

At the completion of the one year academy, the expected outcome for each trainee is to obtain and sustain full-time employment in order to establish financial independence.
